MADISON — Jane K. Secord, age 66, of Madison, died of brain cancer on Monday, June 14, 1993, at her home. She was born in Wausau, Wisconsin, on August 6, 1926. She attended Antioch College and graduated with a B.A. in Speech from the University of Wisconsin, where she was also selected for Mortar Board. Jane loved giving service to the community. She was an active member of Covenant Presbyterian Church and the P.E.O. Sisterhood. Jane served as the Madison Civics Club Secretary; a Field Vice President for Black Hawk Council of Girl Scouts; President of the Attic Angel Association; Secretary of the Friends of the Arboretum Board; and on the Board of the Madison Friends of International Students. She devoted many years of service to Meriter Hospital (and formerly Madison General Hospital) serving as Auxiliary President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Medical and Surgical Foundation, and as a long time member of the Board of Directors. Jane felt deeply about the importance of preserving the history of our community and had a special interest in the role women have played in Madison's development. She was a Community Historian for the State Historical Society, as well as archivist/historian for Attic Angels, Pi Beta Phi, and Meriter Hospital. Jane is survived by her husband, John; three children, Mark (Linda) Secord of Seattle, Washington, Jim (Anne) Secord of Cambridge, England, and Laura Secord of St. Paul, Minnesota; two grandchildren, Ben and Bo Secord of Seattle; and a brother, Jerry Kresge of Sheridan, Wyoming. Memorial services will be held on Sunday, June 20, 1993, at 4:00 p.m. at COVENANT PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, 326 South Segoe Road.
